when it was first published in 1953 opinions were sharply divided between those who deplored the apparent extolling of a vicious form of warfare and this who found in heinz schaeffer s account a revealing picture of the german navy s training and methods u boat 977 was the german submarine that escaped to argentina at the end of world war two this epic journey started from bergen in norway where in april 1945 it was temporarily based and took three and a half months to complete because of the continuing allied naval activity the commander decided to make the first part of the journey underwater before surfacing near the west coast of africa u 977 had spent a remarkable sixty six days submerged heinz schaeffer the commander of u 977 wrote a full account of his career

that culminated in this last command it depicts the grueling aspects of a submariner's life aboard a vessel that was subjected to harsh conditions of the sea and oceans as an experienced commander Schaeffer took part in many of the decisive U boat operations in the North Sea and Atlantic Ocean in the final months of the war and in common with most surviving U boat commanders Schaeffer and his crew came under constant attacks from allied aircraft and surface ships the final part of U boat 977 is Schaeffer's account of the journey to Argentina and lays to rest some of the more fanciful sorties that followed its arrival

Starting weeks after Hitler declared war on the United States in mid-December 1941 and lasting until the war with Germany was all but over, 73 German U-boats sustainably attacked New England waters from Montauk, New York to the tip of Nova Scotia at Cape Sable. Fifteen percent of these boats were sunk by allied counterattacks, five surrendered in the region, and three were sunk off New England Block Island, Massachusetts Bay, and off Nantucket. These have proven appealing to divers, with a result that at least three German naval officers or ratings are buried in New England, one having killed himself in the Boston jail cell. There were 34 allied merchant or naval ships sunk by these subs, one of them the *Eagle* was not admitted to have been sunk by the Germans until decades later. Over 1,100 men were thrown in the water, and 545 of them made it ashore in New England ports. 428 were killed. Importantly, saboteurs were landed three places: Long Island, Frenchman's Bay, Maine, and New Brunswick, Canada, and Boston was mined. Very little was known about this.

u boat 977 is a terrible heroic record from the other side of the battle of the atlantic it is a tale of allied ships sunk of attack of counterattack and finally of defeat of the u boats it was written by one of the few desperate men who survived that defeat completely authentic intensely dramatic it is a personal record of hitler s most insidious and effective military arm it begins when the author was a young man starting his training for u boat service and carries through the sinkings of allied ships and the miraculous escapes that brought him his fame it tells of our growing anti u boat war and the horror of the coming of the worst enemy radar and finally he recounts his last incredible dash across the atlantic with its stretch of sixty six days under the sea to surrender in the argentine and face the charge that u 977 had been hitler s escape ship here also both in the words and between the lines is a view of the nazi military machine as seen by one of its human cogs a moving terrible and valuable picture presented in terms of dramatic action

the title is derived from george bernard shaw s comment that england and america are two countries divided by a common language it is not intended to imply that the two navies were seriously at odds with one another but rather to suggest as in the case of language that common roots and usages varied significantly and the second world war is a pertinent moment for comparison they fought on the same side against a common enemy for nearly four years but britain fought the war for the survival of itself and its empire though in the long term it failed with the latter while the american government fought to maintain its influence through the balance of power its people fought for revenge for pearl harbor and out of a sense of justice in this new book brian lavery describes and analyzes the differences and similarities between the two navies and in doing so sheds fascinating light on how the naval war was fought for example both navies had spectacular failures after entering the war the royal navy off norway the usn at pearl harbor and savo island paradoxically both commenced the war with quite amateur performances by professional navies and ended with highly skilled performances by largely amateur manned forces the training systems for regular officers had flaws in both countries in britain entry was largely dependent on family income in america on political influence but american officers probably had a broader perspective by the time they entered active service the book covers ships and weapons systems for instance the british used too many gun types in the 4 to 6in range while the americans concentrated on the well designed 5in and the author describes conditions onboard ships british vessels were

awash with alcohol which had its attractions for americans when alongside the americans offered ice cream in return these examples represent only a tiny proportion of the subjects covered in this stimulating analysis aviation the marines of both navies anti submarine and mine warfare uniforms propulsion systems shipbuilding and building programs commanders and national leaders ratings and officers ship design geographical environments naval bases hammocks and bunks the deployment of women these are among the myriad big and small themes that will open the eyes of naval historians and enthusiasts and show anyone with an interest in the second world war how these two great allies came together to defeat the axis forces
